Narrative Summary:

Davidson built up a substantial number of points midway through the round with Lenoir-Rhyne trailing them by 1000 points or so. Berry made a run toward the end and was in position to move ahead of Lenoir-Rhyne heading into the Final Jeopardy question. Among all four schools, only Berry College answered the Final Jeopardy question correctly, but their wager did not advance them past Lenoir-Rhyne nor help them overtake Davidson.
